

SPINK COUNTY DRAINAGE BOARD
March 27, 2012

The Spink County Drainage Board met on March 27, 2012, at 10:30 AM. Jeff Albrecht, Dave Albrecht, Brian Johnson, Craig Johnson and Kimberly Markley, Drainage Administrator were present. Jerry Zerbel was absent. A copy of the visitor sign in sheet is available in the Spink County Equalization office.

Craig Johnson made the motion to approve the agenda, seconded by Brian Johnson. Motion carried. Brian Johnson made the motion, seconded by Jeff Albrecht, to approve the minutes of February 14, 2012 after amending the minutes to: "recommend a \$100 a day fine for each day after April 1st that work is not completed".

Peterson-Bixler Hearing N ½ 32-114-62, SE ¼ 33-114-62 and S 80 Acres NE ¼ 33-114-62

Lenny Peterson and Jim Millar discussed moving an outlet on a previously issued permit and requested that the board table or remove the N ½ 32-114-62 from the application to be discussed at the hearing today. Jim Millar supplied two elevation maps for S ½ 33-114-62. Mr. Peterson & Mr. Millar discussed the request to install drain tile on the SE ¼ 33-114-62 and the S 80 acres of NE ¼ 114-62 with the outlet in the SE ¼ 33-114-62. Tim Anderson and his attorney Jack Hieb voiced concerns about the amount of water that will run across his land located in the SW ¼ 34-114-62 and how it will affect the township road. Mr. Hieb requested a detail tile plan and elevations so they could have an engineer review the project. Richard Rathjen also expressed his concerns about the amount of water and affects the project may have on downstream landowners. Mike Sentell told the board he felt water from Belmont Township would affect this project and possibly the roads. After board discussion and questions Craig Johnson made a motion to approve moving the outlet to the dugout on SE ¼ 33-114-62 for permit #7-2011, second by Jeff Albrecht. Motion carried. Brian Johnson made a motion to table the tiling project until a tile plan and elevations for SE ¼ 33-114-62 and S 80 acres of NE ¼ 33-114-62 are received, second by Jeff Albrecht. Motion carried.

Pat Kramp Hearing NE ¼ 25-120-62

Patrick Kramp and Jim Millar explained the application to install drain tile on the NE ¼ 25-120-62 to help with the salt issue on Mr. Kramp's land. Delton Hitchcock and Lovila Hanson owners of adjacent land expressed concerns of more water sitting on their land. Dawn Shepard shared information about several studies on the affects of tiling on downstream land. Jim McComsey renter of the Hansen land was also concerned about more water sitting on the adjacent land. After board discussion and questions Brian Johnson made a motion to approve the tile project for Patrick Kramp on NE ¼ 25-120-62, second by Jeff Albrecht. Motion carried.

Markley reported a permit was issued to Paul Lemmer on E ½ NW ¼ 26-117-65. It was the consensus of the board that townships would pay the same application fees if they filed a drainage application. Brian Johnson made a motion to adjourn as Spink County Drainage Board and reconvene as Spink County Commissioners at 11:55 am, seconded by Craig Johnson. Motion carried.
