

SPINK COUNTY DRAINAGE BOARD
April 5, 2011

The Spink County Drainage Board met on April 5, 2011, at 9:30 AM. Chairman Dave Albrecht called the meeting to order with Brian Johnson, Jeff Albrecht, Craig Johnson, Jerry Zerbel, and Kimberly Markley, Drainage Administrator present. Visitors Mike & Wendy Beckler were also present.

Craig Johnson made the motion to approve the agenda after adding Conde area drainage ditch, Les Little application and culvert issue in Great Bend Township, Brian Johnson seconding the motion. Motion carried.

Jeff Albrecht made the motion, seconded by Jerry Zerbel, to approve the minutes from March 15, 2011. Motion carried.

Wendy and Mike Beckler discussed issues concerning the property they own along Snake Creek. What are the tiling requirements and long terms plans in regard to downstream landowners like themselves? They discussed the spring flooding problems, issues with moving the house across a bridge, and assessment concerns.

The Drainage Board discussed the drainage ditch in the Conde area. It was the consensus of the board that a drainage permit is not necessary to maintain the existing ditch. There is some paper work required by the FSA office.

It was the consensus of the board to refund the application fee to Les Little and explain that a Drainage Permit is not need to replace a culvert in the township road. It is under the authority of the township board.

Dave Albrecht updated the board on an issue in Great Bend Township concerning a culvert on a county road. The interested parties are trying to come to an agreement before involving the county.

Craig Johnson made a motion to adjourn as Spink County Drainage Board and convene as the Planning & Zoning Board at 10:15 am, seconded by Jerry Zerbel. Motion carried.
