

SPINK COUNTY DRAINAGE BOARD  
May 31, 2011

The Spink County Drainage Board met on May 31, 2011, at 9:45 AM. Chairman Dave Albrecht called the meeting to order with Jeff Albrecht, Craig Johnson, Jerry Zerbel, Brian Johnson and Kimberly Markley, Drainage Administrator present. Visitors attending were Robert Roeber, Steve Schaller, Jeff Haessig, Spink County Highway Superintendent, and Victor Fischbach, Spink County State's Attorney.

Jeff Albrecht made the motion to approve the agenda, seconded by Craig Johnson. Motion carried.

Jerry Zerbel made the motion, seconded by Brian Johnson, to approve the minutes from May 17, 2011. Motion carried.

Fischbach discussed with the board an application from Steven Schaller, Austin Schuelke and Dale Washnok. The project is on the north side of County Road 2. A trench is proposed in the road right of way starting in SW ¼ 34-121-61 and continue east to the natural drainage named Dry Run which flows north. Upon advice from the State's Attorney a motion was made by Jeff Albrecht to approve the drainage permit upon the condition it is also approved by Brown County, second by Brian Johnson. Motion carried.

The request from Harvey Wollman to install culvert under Hwy 37 south of 184<sup>th</sup> Street was discussed. The area was inspected by board members after the May 17<sup>th</sup> meeting. It was the consensus of the Drainage Board that they are in agreement with the recommendation of the State DOT and will not require a permit from the county.

Jeff Albrecht made a motion to adjourn as Spink County Drainage Board and convene as the County Commissioners at 9:10 am, seconded by Jerry Zerbel. Motion carried.
