

SPINK COUNTY DRAINAGE BOARD  
June 28, 2011

The Spink County Drainage Board met on June 28, 2011, at 10:30 AM. Chairman Dave Albrecht called the meeting to order with Jeff Albrecht, Jerry Zerbel, Brian Johnson and Kimberly Markley, Drainage Administrator present. Craig Johnson was absent.

Brian Johnson made the motion to approve the agenda, seconded by Jeff Albrecht. Motion carried.

Jerry Zerbel made the motion, seconded by Jeff Albrecht, to approve the minutes from May 31, 2011. Motion carried.

Markley asked the board if they would like to have the Beadle County Commissioners approve an application for a project that the mile and one half from the drain outlet would drain into Beadle County. It was the consensus of the board that we will require the County Commission's approval on all projects that the mile and one half from the drain outlet drains into another county.

Markley also questioned if a new application is required when someone would like to add tile line to an existing drainage system or add additional outlets to an existing drain. It was the consensus of the board to require another permit.

The board also agreed that they do not have jurisdiction over projects that start in other counties and drain into Spink County.

Markley issued the permit for Schaller/Washnok/Schuelke. Markley also updated the board regarding a question with the drainage ditch in the north part of the county which Joe Henjum and Chad Hearnen inquired about and Keith Lambert's project in a township ditch.

Markley report that the drainage dispute that was on the agenda was not filed therefore no action is required at this time.

Brian Johnson made a motion to adjourn as Spink County Drainage Board and convene as the County Commissioners at 11:00 am, seconded by Jerry Zerbel. Motion carried.
