

SPINK COUNTY DRAINAGE BOARD
July 5, 2011

The Spink County Drainage Board met on July 5, 2011, at 9:40 AM. Chairman Dave Albrecht called the meeting to order with Jeff Albrecht, Jerry Zerbel, Brian Johnson, Craig Johnson and Kimberly Markley, Drainage Administrator present. Jim Millar was also present.

Craig Johnson made the motion to approve the agenda, seconded by Jeff Albrecht. Motion carried.

Brian Johnson made the motion, seconded by Jerry Zerbel, to approve the minutes from June 28, 2011. Motion carried.

Discussion was held regarding which signatures should be required from the township board to issue a drainage permit. It was the consensus of the board that the township supervisors are the voting members therefore the three supervisor's signatures should be required. The applicant could also provide signed minutes from a meeting of the township board with a majority vote of the township board.

Discussion was also held to define when a new permit is required. Adding a tile line or drain outlet that does not add additional landowner signatures is permitted if the work is on the legal description listed on the application. If an additional outlet would include more landowners one and one half mile downstream from the outlet, the additional signatures would be required before the outlet is added.

Craig Johnson made a motion to adjourn as Spink County Drainage Board and convene as the Planning & Zoning Board 10:10 am, seconded by Brian Johnson. Motion carried.
