

SPINK COUNTY DRAINAGE BOARD
August 31, 2010

The Spink County Drainage Board met on August 31, 2010 at 10:30 AM. Chairman Dave Albrecht called the meeting to order with Jeff Albrecht, Brian Johnson, Jerry Zerbel, Drainage Administrator Kimberly Markley, and Ron Kopplin present.

Jeff Albrecht made the motion to approve the agenda with no additions; Jerry Zerbel seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Brian Johnson made the motion to approve the minutes from the August 17, 2010, drainage meeting; Jeff Albrecht seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Ron Kopplin presented a concern he has on the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of 1-114-64. The area of the pond close to his farm yard has increased and has overflowed into his feed lots. Mr. Kopplin supplied maps and photos of the area. The board recommended he apply for a drainage permit.

The board discussed the ordinances and possible changes. The board discussed wetland determinations, notifications of $\frac{1}{2}$ mile upstream and 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ miles downstream land owners, and changes to the application form. The board will discuss changes at a future meeting.

There are two meetings coming up soon that will be discussing drainage issues. SD Cooperative Extension Service will be hosting a meeting on Sept. 16th in Huron. The SD Planners Association is also having a session on drainage at their annual conference in October.

The correspondence filed was a notice of an Extension agricultural drainage forum set for Sept 16 in Huron.

Jeff Albrecht made a motion to adjourn as Spink County Drainage Board and reconvene as Spink County Commissioners, at 11:00 am, second by Jerry Zerbel. Motion carried.
