

SPINK COUNTY DRAINAGE BOARD

October 4, 2011

The Spink County Drainage Board met on October 4, 2011, at 10:30 AM. Chairman Dave Albrecht called the meeting to order with Jeff Albrecht, Jerry Zerbel, Brian Johnson, Craig Johnson and Kimberly Markley, Drainage Administrator present. Visitors present were Jim Millar, Richard Rathjen, Dave Willis, Mike Sentell, Tim Anderson, Lenny Peterson, Brad Bixler, Darrell Raschke, and LoriJo Mundstock.

Craig Johnson made the motion to approve the agenda, seconded by Brian Johnson. Motion carried. Brian Johnson made the motion, seconded by Jeff Albrecht, to approve the minutes from September 27, 2011.

Jeff Albrecht made the motion to remove the Peterson Farms hearing from the table, second by Craig Johnson. Motion carried.

Proponents: Brad Bixler Cornwall Township Board Supervisor said the proposed project does not affect the township and would help the township roads. He presented maps and costs to fix roads the last two years. Jim Millar and Lenny Peterson presented the tile plan and maps. They explained the project and told the board that wet land determinations were completed.

Opponents: Richard Rathjen told the board it is a property rights issue and downstream land could lose value. He believes that this project would hurt people downstream. Tim Anderson has concerns about the gravel road and a buildup of ice in the spring.

Board discussion was held. Craig Johnson made a motion to approve the tiling project up to the ridge in the SW corner of 32-114-62 but cannot drain west of the ridge and delete the 2 twelve inch tile lines, seconded by Brian Johnson. Motion carried.

Chairman Albrecht declared the meeting adjourned at 11:30 AM.
