

**SPINK COUNTY COMMISSION PROCEEDINGS  
REDFIELD, SOUTH DAKOTA**

The Spink County Board of Commissioners met at 8:30 AM on Tuesday, August 13, 2013, at the Spink County Courthouse. Present were Commissioners Dave Albrecht, Jeff Albrecht, Craig Johnson, Pat Kramp and Cindy Schultz. Chairman Dave Albrecht opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

**ADOPT AGENDA**

Motion was made by Johnson, seconded by Schultz, to adopt the agenda. All members voted aye. Motion carried.

**MINUTES APPROVED**

Motion was made by Schultz, seconded by J. Albrecht, to approve the minutes of the July 30, 2013 and August 6, 2013 Commission meetings. All members voted aye. Motion carried.

**ON-SALE LIQUOR LICENSE FEE**

A review of the current on-sale liquor license fee was done, with a request for more information to be presented at the next meeting.

**STATES ATTORNEY**

Vic Fischbach, States Attorney, gave an update of activities and answered questions on the SD Rural Attorney Recruitment Program. Motion was made by Kramp, seconded by Schultz, for Spink County to apply to the SD Rural Attorney Recruitment Program to determine eligibility. All members voted aye. Motion carried.

**HIGHWAY SUPERINTENDENT**

Jeff Haessig, Highway Superintendent, gave an update of activities, stated the bid process for bridgework with the JRWDD grant money would be delayed due to permits that are still needed from the Corps of Engineers, and presented an Application for Occupancy on the Right-of-Way of County Highways.

Motion was made by J. Albrecht, seconded by Kramp, to approve WEB Water Development Assoc.'s Application for Occupancy on the Right-of-Way of County Highways for Spink County 14, 25-118N-65W. All members voted aye. Motion carried.

**SHERIFF**

Kevin Schurch, Sheriff, gave an update of activities, filed his monthly report and filed a report detailing the number of female and male prisoners and the number of days housed.

**HISTORICAL SOCIETY/MUSEUM**

Kathy Maddox, Spink County Historical Society, discussed the concern of underground tanks on the location offered to place the Deiter Schoolhouse, Commissioner Johnson will assist in contacting DENR.

**EMERGENCY MANAGER**

Larry Tebben, Emergency Manager, gave an update of activities and discussed his budget needs through the end of 2013.

**PLANNING & ZONING**

At 9:58 AM a motion was made by J. Albrecht, seconded by Schultz, to recess as a Board of County Commissioners and convene as a Planning & Zoning Board. All members voted aye. Motion carried.

At 10:30 AM the Board of Spink County Commissioners reconvened following adjournment as a Planning & Zoning Board.

**CMH PHYSICIAN RECRUITMENT**

Dr. Matthew Owens, Community Memorial Hospital, discussed a physician recruitment plan CMH would like to establish with support from CMH, the City of Redfield, Spink County and Redfield Development Corporation over a 4 year period.

**WELFARE DIRECTOR**

Ann Bottum, Welfare Director, presented a request for preapproval of services for client #211. Motion was made by Johnson, seconded by J. Albrecht, to pre-approve, as per SDCL 28-13-32.9, the request by client #211 for IV antibiotics daily at home for 6 weeks beginning 08/14 through 09/25/13, pending the denial of other resources, noting the client’s ability to pay \$7306.22. All members voted aye. Motion carried.

**TREASURER**

Kathy Ludwig, Treasurer, requested the following: taxes payable in 2013 for Record #8609 be abated as it was a property taken by the County for tax deed; how to proceed in collecting taxes for Record #12396; and forgive interest on back taxes for Record #10044. Kim Markley, Director of Equalization, was present and provided information on Record #12396. Commissioners stated to consult with the States Attorney on Record #12396 and no action was taken on Record #10044. Motion was made by Kramp, seconded by J. Albrecht, to abate \$300.68 of 2012 payable in 2013 taxes for Record #8609, due to the fact it was a property taken by the County for tax deed. All members voted aye. Motion carried.

**DIRECTOR OF EQUALIZATION**

Kim Markley, Director of Equalization, discussed the use of an engineer for drainage issues and a program that would assist in using Lidar information. Markley also stated she will be charging the \$25 fee for all data dump requests and that her office will be closing at 4:00 PM on August 30, 2013.
