

PROCEDURE FOR APPLYING
FOR
TEMPORARY CAFO PERMIT

1. The owner petitions to the Spink County Planning and Zoning Board for a Temporary CAFO Permit before applying to the State.
- 2. The owner or the petitioner must stake out the location of the new building before the hearing date and notify the Zoning Administrator at 472-4585 when this has been done. The Zoning Administrator will then measure and take pictures of the site. A drone may be used to take pictures.**
3. Landowners or tenants living within the setback area must be notified by certified mail at least seven (7) days before the hearing by the Spink County Planning and Zoning Board, that a hearing will take place concerning a proposed Concentrated Animal Feeding Operation (CAFO).
4. The Spink County Zoning Administrator gives notice in the local newspapers ten (10) days prior to the Planning and Zoning hearing.
5. After the Temporary Permit and a Waiver from distance (if setbacks are not met), have been met, the owner may petition to the State for a General Permit.
6. Once the Temporary Permit requirements have been met and the Zoning Administrator receives an approved copy of the General Permit from the State, the County CAFO Permit will be filed with the Register of Deeds.
