

SPINK COUNTY DRAINAGE BOARD

April 6, 2010

The Spink County Drainage Board met on April 6, 2010 at 10:30 am. Chairman Dave Albrecht called the meeting to order with Jeff Albrecht, Brian Johnson, Craig Johnson, Jerry Zerbel and Drainage Administrator Kimberly Markley present. Guests present were Jim & Judy Hansen, Darrel Remily and Gary Remily applicants, Lori Jo Mundstock, *Redfield Press*.

Markley reported that the letter from NRSC was received and the hearing can continue. Markley submitted pictures of the area taken on 3/31/10.

Jim Hansen believes an engineering study and surveying needs to be done.

Darrel Remily suggested that maybe a gate could be installed on the culvert to regulate the flow of water. It was questioned who would control the gate. Gary Remily also submitted pictures of the area that were taken on March 30, 2010.

The culvert size was questioned. The application did not indicate culvert size. Jim Hansen stated that the township board has denied putting a culvert in this area in the 1960s. Hansen & Remily answered question from the drainage board.

A motion was made by Jeff Albrecht to deny the application to install the culvert, second by Craig Johnson. Motion carried unanimously.

Other culvert and drainage options were discussed.

A motion to approve the minutes from March 16, 2010 was made by Jerry Zerbel, second by Brian Johnson. Motion carried.

The board reviewed a letter on ditch maintenance. Markley informed the board about other calls received in her office regarding other drainage issues.

At 11:00 am a motion to adjourn as a the Spink County Drainage Board and reconvene as the Spink County Planning and Zoning Board was made by Brian Johnson and seconded by Jeff Albrecht. Motion carried.
