

**SPINK COUNTY DRAINAGE
REDFIELD, SOUTH DAKOTA
UNAPPROVED MINUTES**

The Spink County Drainage Board met October 21, 2025 at 9:45 AM with board members Dave Albrecht, Brian Johnson, Suzanne Smith, Brett Knox and Kevin Siebrecht present. Denise Fliehe, Drainage Administrator was also present. A list of all visitors present at the hearings is available in the Spink County equalization Office.

Motion was made by Suzanne Smith to approve the agenda. Seconded by Kevin Siebrecht. Motion to approve the minutes from 09/02/2025 made by Suzanne Smith, seconded by Brett Knox. All voted Aye. Motion carried.

A drainage hearing was held for Boekelheide Real Estate who have applied for a drainage permit to: Install drain tile and outlet into the SW ¼ of 30-120-64.

Scott Boekelheide presented his project and answered questions from the board. Jim Millar, Precision Soil, also spoke in favor of the project. Landowner Colin Hogue presented opposition for the project. The board closed public comment and board held a discussion on the matter. Motion to approve the project was made by Suzanne Smith, seconded by Kevin Siebrecht. Poll was taken with Dave Albrecht voting Nay, all others, Aye. Motion carried to approve the drainage project in the SW ¼ of 30-120-64

A drainage hearing was held for a joint project including Boekelheide Real Estate, Bill Ford (Curt) & Mark Fischbach to:
Install drain tile into all of section 31-120-63 with outlet being in SW ¼ 31-120-63.

Scott Boekelheide presented the project to the board, with input from Mark Fischbach and Curt Ford. There was no one present who opposed the project. The board discussed the matter. Suzanne Smith made a motion to approve the project, with Dave Albrecht seconding. All members voted Aye. Motion carried to approve the drainage project in section 31-120-63.

Brian Johnson made a motion at 10:23 am to adjourn as a Drainage Board and proceed to Planning and Zoning. Seconded by Suzanne Smith. All voted Aye.
